THE RULES FOR THE PROGRAM ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Eight classes will be sponsored annually, with one class in each of the following provinces; British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Ontario, Quebec, New Brunswick and Nova Scotia.
- 2. The Clydesdale Horse Association of Canada Board of Directors will annually approve the eight qualifying shows, with the Directors bringing a recommendation for their province to the Board.
- 3. In provinces with several qualifying shows, the Clydesdale Horse Association of Canada Board of Directors may choose to move the Canadian Clydesdale Four Horse Hitch Incentive Program annually. In the province of Ontario, alternating between shows in Western and Eastern Ontario each year, is recommended.
- 4. Qualifying shows should have;
- A Four Horse Hitch Class.
- The Four Horse Hitch Class may include exhibitors of other draft breeds; however awards will ONLY be paid to qualifying Clydesdale exhibitors.
- 5. Award Payments will only be made to Canadian hitches, which are Clydesdale Horse Association of Canada members, and who participated in the class.
- 6. An award of \$100 will be given to each qualifying Clydesdale hitch, to a maximum of \$500 per provincial show. In the event of more than five qualifying hitches in a class, the Board of Directors will review and make a decision on the distribution of payments.
- 7. Payment will be made by the Secretary of the Clydesdale Horse Association of Canada directly to the exhibitors. Directors of the Clydesdale Horse Association of Canada will submit their province results, including the exhibitor names and addresses, to the Association Secretary by October 31st, of the show year.
